REGISTRATION: Enrollments must be made at least two weeks before the chosen course starts. Please sign up online on our website. The form contained in this folder should only be used in exceptional cases. If used, please enclose a proof of payment for the deposit amount of € 150.00. Upon receipt of the enrollment form and (deposit) payment we will send you a confirmation of your registration (providing detailed information on course and accommodation if applicable) as well as your invoice.

DEPOSIT AND PAYMENTS: If you don’t sign up online please arrange for a bank transfer to Raiffeisenlandesbank Kärnten, 9020 Klagenfurt am Wörthersee, Austria, IBAN: AT81 3900 0000 0103 7415 | BIC/SWIFT: RZKTAT2K. When you use our booking platform, you can choose from a variety of payment methods and decide whether you want to pay only a deposit or the full amount (3% discount). **Participants must pay in full for the course and accommodation if needed, in Euro, two weeks before the beginning of the course.**

FEES: Our course fees cover course and study materials. For course books that have already been provided (i.e. in a previous course) no course fee reductions are made. Lower rates are only applicable for course bookings for a minimum of 6 consecutive weeks. They do NOT apply if participants decide to extend their course.

CANCELLING CONDITIONS: In case you wish to cancel your course, please let us know promptly in writing. Those, who cancel seven working days before the start of the course will be fully refunded minus € 150.00 cancellation fee. If you cancel later, do not start your course at all or drop out, there will be no refund. We recommend to take out travel insurance. Should your visa application be rejected and you provide written proof thereof, payments will be refunded minus € 150.00.

INSURANCE: No insurance is included in our course fees. Please contact your health insurance company to check if your insurance is valid abroad too. If not, please take out an appropriate insurance.

Course Method, Content, and Examinations

Course Method and Content

In communicative language teaching with individual attention, you practise the four language skills (speaking, writing, listening and reading) addressing current topics and working with authentic texts. Alongside the additional training in vocabulary and grammar, 2 lessons a week are given on phonetics, taught by our team of specialized pronunciation trainers. It goes without saying that the language proficiency level of our participants is monitored constantly.

Course content: The selection of topics included in the lesson is based on the specifications of the CEFR and the textbooks based on them, taking into account the respective level. Additionally, the interests and needs of participating learners are taken into account. In particular, topics inherent to culture and cultural studies are discussed.

Course Examinations and Certificates

To receive a course certificate, students must attend at least 80% of classes, participate regularly, and pass the midterm and final exams.

Certificates contain the following information: number of TU; overall grade; language level at which the course was conducted; individual assessment of the four language proficiency areas after at least three weeks of course participation.
